A brief report of the proceedings during both these days is as follows:

Dr. Rasmi A, Head of the Department of Computer Science and Engineering, welcomed the students to the workshop and introduced the Talrop Steyp team Mr. Dinoj C, Technology Head, Steyp and Avin Preraj, Senior Software Engineer, Steyp.

The entire workshop could be divided into two sessions

Session 1 was a theory session conducted from 10.00 AM to 12.10 PM. Mr. Dinoj introduced the audience to the basics of Application Development using Android Studio. They also demonstrated how to install Android Studio for Windows and gave a tour of the Interface. They also explained about the basics of HTML and JavaScript. The participants were also familiarized with concepts of Activities and Lifecycle of Activities.

Session 2 was a practical session conducted from 1:00 PM to 3:45 PM. In the Computer Laboratories the team helped the participants set up Android Studio on the devices. Layouts for the user interface were discussed. The team explained about the project that they already created.

At the end of the workshop the team gave the link of sample project that they created and asked the students to download and run the application. As the time was limited, the students were given the opportunity to call them at any time if they are having any doubts. The workshop concluded at 3.45 PM.
